
The Gathering Place will be open 6-8pm on Wednesday Feb. 18th for prayer, ashes, a candle lighting and a blessing. Come and go as you please.





### AN UPDATE FROM OUR PARTNER ORGANIZATION- THE PRESBYTERIAN COUNSELING CENTER

PCC currently contracts with 17 therapists across these 9 locations. Last year we scheduled a total of 13,742 appointments and held 10,612 sessions in all-- more than 5% of all PCC sessions were held at the WBTS office! We actually expect that number to be higher in 2026! In 2025, our total income from clinical services, grants, donations and church support was \$893,847. Our total donations were \$8,052; our total fundraising was \$9,320 after expenses, and our total church support was \$19,335. We appreciate your referrals, the independence of WBTS house and the prayerful and financial support exceeding \$10,000 in 2025! WBTS has provided more than half of our total church donations in support of PCC's mission for mental health services and awareness-- we are incredibly thankful!

Church donations go directly to our Counseling Fund, which supports clients whose copay or deductible are prohibitive. This fund also helps bridge the gap to sliding scale support for those without insurance or Employee Assistance Plan (EAP) benefits. Other funding sources include grant funding of \$27,000 from the United Way Community Impact health pillar, and partnership agreements with Volusia Recovery Alliance for first responders and trauma victims, Domestic Abuse Council & Family Life Center for domestic and sexual violence survivors, and Volusia County schools BRAVE program (Be Resilient & Voice Emotions).

Our referral sources include a host of primary care physicians & psychiatrists, Halifax Behavioral, Advent Health, Flagler schools, Neighbor to Family, Family Renew, Halifax Habitat, Easter Seals, Good Samaritan Clinic, West Volusia Housing Authority, and other community agencies.

At the end of February, 2026, PCC will celebrate 40 years of service to the community as a mission of the supporting Presbyterian churches in the area. We appreciate the part that Westminster by-the-Sea Presbyterian has played, as a beacon, as a mission, and as a supporter of mental health and awareness in our community and in Volusia County. THANK YOU for all you do to support and advance our impact and our mission.
